NOTICE OF DECISION TO TAKE ACTION ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS

In accordance with section 4-168(e) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA), pursuant to section 4-167(a)(2) of the Connecticut General Statutes, has decided to proceed with proposed amended regulations concerning the promulgation of regulations by the PURA to amend certain PURA rules of practice and to establish rules for uncontested proceedings. Notice of Intent to amend these regulations was posted to the regulations webpage of the Secretary of the State on March 13, 2014.

PURA held a public hearing on May 7, 2014, and accepted comments to solicit public input regarding the proposed amended regulations. PURA received three written comments, which is available for public inspection in Docket No. 14-02-11 through PURA's website.

As required by the Freedom of Information Act and Conn. Gen. Stat. §4-168(e), the following items are available for viewing:

- (A) The final wording of the proposed regulation;
- (B) A statement of the principal reasons in support of this intended action; and
- (C) A statement of the principal considerations in opposition to this intended action and the reasons for accepting or rejecting such considerations.
