NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND REGULATION

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to the authority of sections 14-15, 14-33, 14-48c and 14-137 of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to adopt technical amendments to Department of Motor Vehicles Regulations.

Statement of purpose: The purpose of this proposal is to modernize the agency's regulations in light of the Governor's Executive Order # 37. The proposal incorporates amendments to six existing regulations and reflects updates to conform to our current DMV statutes and requirements. It also incorporates technical drafting changes adopted by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the General Assembly. All of the proposed amendments are technical in nature with no legal impact to the public.
