## Prescription Drug Drop Box Program and Locations

### Purpose:

The medication collection and disposal program provides a safe disposal location for citizens to properly dispose of unused household medications.

### What CAN and CANNOT be discarded in local medication drop-boxes

- YES:**
- Over-the-counter medications
  - Prescription medications
  - Medication samples
  - Medications for household pets
  - Medicated lotions or ointments
- NO:**
- Needles or other "sharps"
  - Hazardous waste
  - Thermometers
  - Personal care products (shampoo, etc.)
